Enrichment Week— Wednesday 10th July - Friday 12th July 2019

As a school we are constantly seeking ways to improve and enhance your child's educational experience. We have organised three Enrichment Days which will provide your son/daughter with a range of different and exciting alternatives to the normal curriculum.

During these days, the school will be suspending normal lessons and will instead be offering a wide range of activities. From the timetable in this booklet you will notice that your son/daughter has a number of open choices. These sessions will last for a whole day (9am - 3pm) or even the full three days, depending on the activity they choose. The activities on offer are contained within this booklet.

Students are permitted to wear non-uniform clothes for all activities. We would ask that all students dress appropriately for the activities they choose, especially those that could prove to be wet or muddy, we advise no denim jeans to be worn for this type of activity! For every off-site activity a parent/carer must complete a parental consent form; this must be returned to **reception.** Please note that activities will incur a charge and all payments must be paid on the day that your child signs up. The Ambleside visit will work slightly different and students will be required to pay a £60.00 deposit on the day, with the final balance being paid by no later than Monday 10 June.

For the majority of off-site activities students will need a packed lunch. If your child is currently receiving Free School Meals and would like a packed lunch provided by the school, please complete the reply slip enclosed at the back of this booklet. If the reply slip is not completed, a packed lunch will NOT be provided for your son/daughter and it will therefore be your responsibility to provide lunch for your child. The completed slip should also be returned to reception.

Students will also have to take responsibility for checking which activities are available to them, signing up for the activities and returning their choice form to reception as soon as possible. Students should note that there will be a limited number of places for each open choice, with 'first-come, first-served' operating in most cases.

We hope you will agree that the Enrichment Days have the potential to offer a stimulating and worthwhile contribution to your child's life at school. We would like to thank you for your ongoing support of the school and look forward to hearing your comments on the matter in due course.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- Friday 4 April Information booklets to students
- Students sign up in the School Hall with the key member of staff shown in the booklet. Parent/ Guardian must sign the preference form and payment must be made, on the day, to confirm the student place. If student does not pay on the day then they will not be able to sign up for the trip.
- Ambleside payment If your child signs up for the Ambleside trip then this will require a £60.00 deposit. The balance will be required to be paid by 10th June.
- Once your child has signed up and paid for a trip, their place will be secured and choices will not be allowed to be changed. Payments will also become nonrefundable.
