12-15 Vaccination Programme

The 12-15 Covid-19 Vaccination Programme has now been running for over a month in schools across Northumberland.

Whilst we have had a good take up of those wishing to be vaccinated in school, we are aware there are still many families that missed the opportunity to get their child vaccinated during that time.

If your child is aged 12-15 and you would like to get them vaccinated, you can do so by booking a vaccination at one of the sites across Northumberland at <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/coronavirus-vaccination/book-coronavirus-vaccination/>

Consent will be required from both the parent and/or carer and the child on the day of administration of the vaccine.

The Pfizer-BioNTech Covid-19 vaccine will not be administered unless consent is given by both the parent and/or carer and the child.


