## Uniform

At the Moving Up Evening on Wednesday 19 June, you will be able to view and try on our full range of school uniform. Staff from Emblematic will be available to measure your child for our school uniform and assist you with the ordering process.

If you do not want to purchase or order uniform at the Moving Up Evening, you may alternatively choose to order your child's uniform online. Online orders must be placed by Thursday 1 August. Uniform can be delivered to your home address or to the Emblematic store which is based in Bedlington. The store is open to the public; please check the website <u>emblematic.co.uk/bedlington-store/</u> for up-to-date opening times.

## **Transfer Day 2024**

Our Transfer Day will take place on Tuesday 2 July from 8.35am until 2.55pm. On this day, students will spend the full day with us here at Bedlington Academy, spend time with their peers and teachers, and have a chance to sample our school lunches in the school dining hall, free of charge. Your child should come to Bedlington Academy in their normal primary school uniform and will be expected to make their own way to and from Bedlington Academy on the day. Please ensure your child brings trainers in their bag for PE activities.

During the coming weeks, Miss Short (Assistant Headteacher) and other key members of staff will be visiting primary schools to meet teachers, gather crucial transition information and meet your child.
